1) The above consolidated financial results for quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2019 (the results) of Gokak Textiles Limited (The Company) which are published in accordance with Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements), 2015 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee of the Board and subsequently taken on record by the Board of Directors of the Company at their meeting held on February 14, 2020. The standardne financial results are in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) as prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013. The statutory Auditors have conducted limited review of the results and expressed unmodified review conclusion.

2) The Company has consolidated accumulated losses of Rs.31,855.43 lakhs and its current liabilities exceeded current assets by Rs.13691.13 lakhs as at the December 31, 2019. However, current liabilities of Rs. 13016.52 lakhs are loans repayable to Shapoorji Pallonji and Company Private Limited (The Holding Company) and as at December 31, 2019, the Company has a negative net worth of Rs.8423.27 lakhs. The continuity of the operations of the Company is dependent upon the continued operational and financial support of the Holding Company. Based on the reasons stated above and operational and financial support from the Holding Company, the above financial results have been prepared on a going concern basis.

3) On August 3, 2019, there was a ransome-ware attack on the Computer servers of the Company and accounting software of the company was affected and due to which the company had to shift its books of accounts to a new accounting software using the back up of the data available in the servers. The Management of the company has taken appropriate steps and due care regarding the completeness and accuracy of the data while transferring the data to the new software and no significant data was tost due to the said rensomewere effects.

4) During the quarter ended September 30, 2019, hydro power plant of the subsidiary Company (Gokak Power and Energy Limited) situated at Gokak Falls having total capacity of 8 MW was submerged in the flood water due to heavy rains and the power generation has been suspended since August 07, 2019. The Subsidiary Company has estimated the repair and replacement cost of approximately Rs. 3.29 Crores and the said plant is expected to be in operation on or before March 31, 2020. The management is of the opinion that significant portion of the repairs and replacement cost will be recovered through insurance claim and no impairment provision for the said plant is required for the damages incurred.

in addition to the damage of the plant and machinery of the power plant, the canal system was also damaged due to deluge of floods. The flooding/water levels still continue and we expects the floods to recode with passage of monsoon and the extent of damage will be assessed only after the reduction of water levels. The canal system is insured with The Oriental Insurance Company under a Fire, Flood and Earthquake policy and the quantum of claim versus the expenses and the impact on the accounts will be known over once the canal is dry and empty will be reported then, though the management expects limited or no impact on the profit and loss accounts.

5) The consolidated figures for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2016 have been approved by the Board of Directors of the Company and has not been subjeted to limited review by the statutory auditors of the Company.

Independent Auditor's Report on the Quarterly and Year to date Unaudited Consolidated Financial Results of Gokak Textiles Limited pursuant to Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended

#### To Board of Directors of Gokak Textiles Limited

- 1. We have reviewed the unaudited consolidated financial results of Gokak Textiles Limited (hereinafter referred to as the "Holding Company") and its subsidiary (collectively referred to as "the Group") for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2019 ("Consolidated Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('Listing Regulations').
- 2. This Consolidated Statement, which is the responsibility of the Holding Company's management and approved by the Company's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Consolidated Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Consolidated Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33 (8) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, to the extent applicable.

4. This Consolidated Statement includes the results of Holding Company and its Subsidiary i.e. Gokak Power and Energy Limited.

- 5. Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Consolidated Statement of unaudited financial results has not been prepared in all material respects in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations, 2015 including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
- 6. We draw attention to below mentioned notes to the accompanying Consolidated Statement:
  - a. We draw attention to Note 2 of the Consolidated Statement which indicates that the Group has accumulated losses of Rs. 31,855.43 lakhs as on December 31, 2019 and its current liabilities exceed its current assets by Rs. 13,691.13 lakhs as on that date. However, the Consolidated Statement has been prepared on a going concern basis for the reasons stated in the said Note of the Consolidated Statement. Our conclusion is not modified in respect of this matter.
  - b. Attention is drawn to Note 5 of the Consolidated Statement which states that the consolidated figures for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018, as reported in the Consolidated Statement have been approved by the Holding Company's Board of Directors, but have not been subjected to review for the reason explained in the said note.

2) The Company operates in one segment only at standione level, namely Textiles.

3) The Company has standalone accumulated losses of Rs. 25255.96 lakhs and its current liabilities exceeded current assets by Rs. 8784.83 lakhs as at the December 31, 2019. However, current liabilities of Rs. 8271.41 lakhs are loans repayable to Shapoorji Pellonji and Company Private Limited ("the Holding Company") and as at December 31, 2019, the Company has a negative net worth of Rs. 2036.01 lakhs. The continuity of the operations of the Company is dependent upon the continued operational and financial support of the Holding Company. Based on the reasons stated above and operational and financial support from the Holding Company, the above financial results have been prepared on a going concern basis.

4) On August 3, 2019, there was a ransome-ware attack on the Computer servers of the Company and accounting software of the company was affected and due to which the company had to shift its books of accounts to a new accouting software using the back up of the data available in the servers. The Management of the company has taken appropriate steps and due care regarding the completeness and accuracy of the data while transferring the data to the new software and no significant data was lost due to the said ransomeware attack

5) The Company has adopted modified retrospective approach under Ind AS 116 - Leases, with effect from April 01, 2019. Accordingly the Company has recognized 'Right of use' assets of Rs. 15.18 lakhs (including reclassification of leasehold land of Rs 1.50 lakhs) and present value of lease liabilities of Rs. 21.22 lakhs as on April 01, 2019. In the statement of profit and loss for the current period, instead of rent expenses (as accounted under previous periods), amortization of right of use has been accounted under depreciation and amortization expenses and unwinding of discount on lease liabilities has been accounted under finance cost. Accordingly, current period's figures are not comparable with previous periods to that extent. The net impact of adotpting the standard on the results and earnings per share is not material.

6) The figures for the corresponding periods have been regrouped and rearranged wherever necessary, to make them comparable.
